## **Recovering an original Registration Number**

Is the original registration number known?

If yes check with DVLA (0300 790 6820) is the number still available?

Is the machine and all its major components (apart from the engine) original?

Does evidence exist to prove a link between frame number and registration number?

## If the answer is "no", revert to age-related procedure.

Is the machine complete and able to pass the MOT? If so.

Applicant to submit GRA application form plus relevant fee.

Authentication Officer to arrange GRA inspection.

Inspection carried out. GRA form completed. Examiner to submit report form and photos to AO. Applicant to obtain V55/5 (application for registration) and guidance note V355/5 from DVLA (See <a href="http://www.gov.uk/vehicle-registration/new">http://www.gov.uk/vehicle-registration/new</a> registrations)

Applicant to send completed V765 form to AO for GRA endorsement.

Endorsed V765 returned to applicant with dating certificate.

## Applicant submits to DVLA.

Completed V55/5

Completed and endorsed V765.

GRA dating certificate.

Photographs and rubbing of machine and numbers.

Evidence of link between frame number and registration number

MOT certificate (if post 1960 and until May 2018 only)

Insurance certificate.

V55/5 – specified proofs of name and address
